Peacemaking Affirmations Discussion

Beginning this week and moving into next week, our Presbytery will be reflecting on a proposal from the General Assembly that the Advisory Committee on Social Witness Policy (ACSWP) will be taking up shortly. We'll be discussing this in our upcoming Regional Commission meetings.

What is this proposal? In a nutshell, it's a set of ideas for how we ought to react as Christians to more than a decade of war in this country. [Find detailed information about the proposal here.](#)

Why are we talking about this?

Have you ever felt that the positions that the denomination takes nationally don't reflect most of the Presbyterians you know? You're not alone. We're having this conversation largely because there's a perception that the denomination's national voice does not speak for many Presbyterians, so the GA is giving us a chance for our voices to be heard. This is an unprecedented opportunity to tell the denomination what we think on a particular social issue, prior to the preparation of the report that is to guide Peacemaking efforts in the PC(USA).

But why are we, as Presbyterians in Tampa Bay, talking about this? As a connectional church, we have to consider not just local issues, but those of the big "C" Church. Did you know that the PC(USA) has [mission partners in](#)

[Iraq](#)? People in our Presbytery have met these pastors at PC(USA) events, and speak highly of them.

Also, while the wars this document refers to are happening half a world away, this is still a local matter. The headquarters for our military's presence in the Middle East, CENTCOM, is on MacDill Air Force Base, less than a mile from my house. This base is one of the main economic drivers of our region. Additionally, our very own Rev. Libby Shannon (Associate Chaplain at Eckerd College) chaired the GA committee that devised these Affirmations.

So while it may not seem like a pressing issue to some, our region more than most has "skin in the game." I'd encourage you to read the [5 Peacemaking Affirmations](#) and come prepared to share your thoughts with your fellow Presbyters at the Regional Commissions, as we prepare to share our thoughts with the larger Church.
