Expanding the Circle of Moral Concern

Eckerd College, in St. Petersburg, Florida, is a Presbyterian-related college in covenant with the Synod of the South Atlantic. On Saturday, May 21, 2016, about 500 students, parents, faculty, staff, trustees, and guests filled Wireman Chapel on the Eckerd campus for the 2016 Baccalaureate Service. Donald R. Eastman III, President of Eckerd College, spoke about "Expanding the Circle of Moral Concern." His remarks were based on Luke 10:25-37, the parable of the Good Samaritan.

"The story is not primarily intended to illustrate the virtue of charity," said Dr. Eastman, "but to answer the lawyer's question: 'Who is my neighbor?' Jesus's answer was an unprecedented, radical answer: 'Everyone is your neighbor." To read Dr. Eastman's remarks, please visit link here.
