## New Executive and Stated Clerk of the Synod of the South Atlantic Announced

# Report of the Executive Administrative Commission of the Synod of the South Atlantic:

At the Synod Stated Meeting in September 2016, the Executive Administrative Commission (EAC) was authorized to conduct the search for a Synod Executive/Stated Clerk to succeed the Rev. Dr. Heahwan Rim.

We began our work by reviewing the position description and selecting the leadership competencies that we felt were the most relevant and important to fulfill the responsibilities of the Synod Executive/Stated Clerk. Using the Ministry Information Form (MIF) of our denomination, we decided to undertake a national search and post the Synod MIF online with Church Leadership Connection (CLC). During November and December of 2016, we drafted the narrative questions for the MIF and posted the completed MIF the first week of January 2017.

The EAC met twice in face-to- face meetings to review and discuss candidates' Personal Information Forms (PIF). We received a total of 20 PIFs, three of which were matched by CLC. The remaining 17 were self-referred. In March, we narrowed our search to five candidates with whom we conducted Skype interviews on March 18 and 19. Following that meeting, we shared our impressions of the candidates and prayed for God's guidance.

In April, we ranked the three candidates and invited one individual for a faceto- face interview in Jacksonville, Florida on April 10. In our deliberations following the interview, we were unanimous and enthusiastic about extending the call to this candidate, a call she graciously accepted.

We are now delighted to announce our nomination of the Rev. Joyce Lieberman as the Synod of South Atlantic Synod Executive/Stated Clerk. Rev. Lieberman will begin her new responsibilities on June 1, 2017 and will be formally elected by the Synod at its Stated Meeting in September 2017.

Rev. Joyce Lieberman was ordained to the Ministry of Word and Sacrament in the Presbyterian Church (USA) on June 19, 1983.

Lieberman served as associate pastor at First Presbyterian Church, a large downtown congregation, and as interim pastor at Piedmont Presbyterian Church, a redeveloping urban



congregation, both in Portland, Oregon. She served as co-pastor of Immanuel Presbyterian Church, Albuquerque, with her husband, Chris, and as Stated Clerk of the Presbytery of Santa Fe. In March 2008, she began service with the denomination Office of the General Assembly as Associate for Call System Support and currently serves as Associate Stated Clerk for Constitutional Interpretation.

Lieberman is a graduate of the University of Portland, where she earned a Bachelor of Science in Nursing, and San Francisco Theological Seminary, where she earned a Master of Divinity.

Lieberman's husband, Chris, is pastor of Bardstown Road Presbyterian Church in Louisville. She has a daughter, Laura, son-in- law, Zack, and grandsons, Quentin and Max, in Rome, Georgia and a son, Eric and daughter-in- law, Jacque in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

The EAC is grateful to the Synod for your prayers as we have undertaken our work, and believes that the Holy Spirit actively and directly led us to an outstanding candidate to lead our Synod into the future. We feel confident that, building on the Rev. Dr. Rim's legacy, Rev. Lieberman will serve our presbyteries, our leaders, and our churches exceedingly well.

Greetings from the Community Food Pantry,

The Community Food Pantry will be participating in **Give Day Tampa Bay** on May 2nd 2017. **Give Day Tampa Bay** is part of a national event in which communities across the country ask business and individuals to give to their local nonprofits on

one specific day -- May 2, 2017. The theme, *Live Here Give Here*, highlights the fact that all donations given on Give Day will remain right here in the Tampa Bay area. this is the fourth year the Community Foundation of Tampa Bay has sponsored this event, which raised nearly \$2 million for 600 Tampa Bay area nonprofits last year, we are proud to be one of them.

The CFP strives to end the physical and emotional hunger of families in a dignified manner. We serve some of the hard-to-reach areas of Tampa through local agencies and homeless outreach. We also collaborate with the local community garden (Vista Gardens) to compost produce that cannot be served, it's given to the earth and then is returned to the pantry in the form of beautiful fresh veggies for our families, wasting as little as possible at all time.

About a third of people served in our pantry are children, and 10% are seniors. Children at risk of hunger are more likely to be in poor health and struggle in school. Family members in food-insecure households are also more likely to struggle with psychological and behavioral health issues. The CFP takes a comprehensive approach to serving our clients that not only alleviates hunger but also provides support services such as health screenings, veterans' assistance, and nutritional education for the whole person.



# Mediation Skills Training Institute for Church Leaders (Oct.2-6, 2017, Lakeland, FL)

Whether in the home, school, community, church or workplace conflict is an inevitable part of life. Having the skills to function effectively in emotionally intense, conflicted situations is important for all of us, especially those of us who are leaders. The Lombard Mennonite Peace Center has trained hundred of church leaders from a wide range of denominations in the skills that are needed to deal with conflict in the church setting through its Mediation Skills Training Institute. The Mediation Skills Training Institute equips people for working in various conflicted situations, including church disputes. Participants learn about:

- Biblical foundations-finding renewal in conflict.
- Individual styles of response to conflict.
- Win-win negotiation skills.
- Skills to mediate conflict between individuals.
- Tools to effectively manage congregational conflict.
- Skills for serving as an outside consultant to conflicted churches.

The institute includes lectures, discussion, and guided practice in role-plays. Active and practical in focus, the sessions emphasize hands-on skills training and real-life role-plays based on the kinds of conflicts faced by participants.


